

REES FINANCIAL GOALS

- Our goal is to secure \$3,460,000 by the fall of 2019 from members of the community and beyond to stay on track for a 2020 grand reopening, which will be the 80th anniversary year for The REES Theatre.
- We must raise \$1.5MM of our \$3.46MM goal by October 31, 2018 to receive a matching grant of \$300,000 from the Regional Cities Initiative.
- Once open, we anticipate the annual operating expenses to be \$329,000 and we have developed a business plan based on projected, annual event revenues that will sustain its operation.



THE EVENT PLAN


The auditorium is designed in tiers with flexible seating flanked by ADA compliant ramps, accommodating the following types of events:

- Film Presentation: seasonal themes, classics, intergenerational and multicultural selections




Revenue Sources



FLOORPLANS REPRESENTATION OF THE PERSON OF T




BANQUET PLAN
